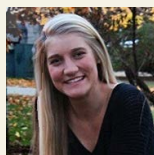
ASU's Dean for Entrepreneurship and Innovation to keynote 2015 *Techie Women Have More... Conference*

CEWiT's new Social Media and Web Design SIGs to present multiple workshops at the 2015 *Techie Women Have More... Conference*

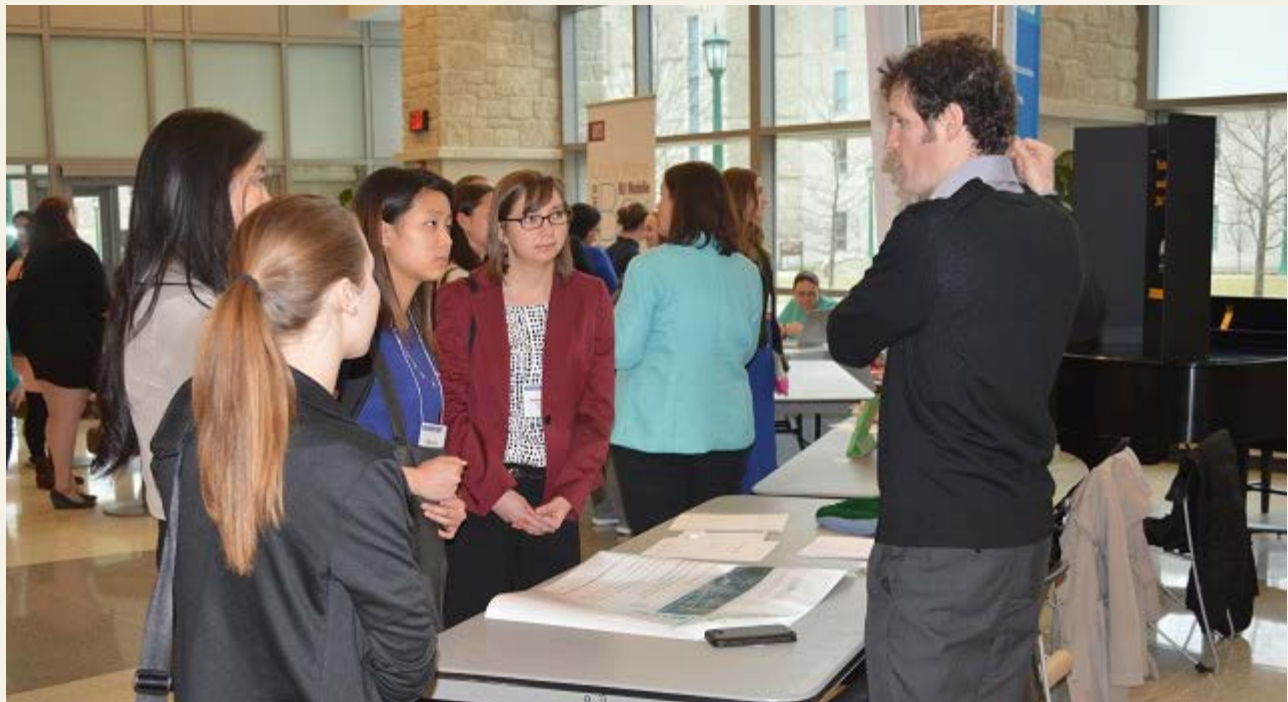
